

**Medication and Treatment Administration:** In the event that your child needs medication while in school, both prescription or over-the-counter, the Harrisburg School District requires a completed *Medication and Treatment Authorization Form* prior to administration. This form needs to be completed by the parent/guardian for OTC medications and parent/guardian AND primary care physician for prescription medications/Herbal medications. Forms can be picked up in the health office in each school building as well as on the parent portal tab of the district website. If at all possible, medications should be scheduled and given outside of school hours. The school district does not provide OTC medications. Medication must be delivered directly to the school nurse/aide or trained personnel by the parent/guardian in the original pharmacy or manufacturer's container. For your child's safety and the safety of other children, students in kindergarten-5th grade are not allowed to carry and self-administer medication. Parent/guardians are responsible to pick up unused medication within one week after the last day of school. If medication is not picked up within one week after school is out, it will be destroyed. Medication renewal is required at the beginning of each school year. Please see this form for further information.
