The First Tee of South Dakota improves the lives of young people by providing educational programs and learning environments that build character, instill life enhancing values, and promote healthy choices through the game of golf. The First Tee Life Skills experience enables participants to learn valuable lessons about the importance of maintaining a positive attitude; how to make decisions by thinking about the possible consequences and how to define and set goals from the golf course to everyday life. Participants learn about themselves and others through a range of experiences enhancing their golf skills as well as their fundamental values for life. As their opportunities on the golf course expand, so do the opportunities for their futures.

All participants receive yardage books & bag tags so their progress can be observed as they advance within The First Tee certification levels of PLAYer, Par, Birdie, Eagle and Ace. At each certification level, participants are introduced to new golf skills and life skills. Life skills such as: Meet & Greet, Character Development, Conflict Resolution, Dreams, Goals, Building a Go-to team, and Appreciating Diversity. The First Tee provides tremendous opportunities for young people to achieve success both in golf and in life,

Birdie level helps participants learn how to identify personal goals and to develop a strategy for reaching their goals both on and off the golf course. Certifying Birdie hours is 48.

What is Eagle?

EAGLE introduces participants to the concept of overall health and wellness. Our program teaches participants that having a healthy body, mind and heart can help a person perform better and get more enjoyment out of golf, as well as help them lead a more productive, satisfying life in general. Certifying Eagle hours is 60.
